Overview:

Reports directly to the Airfield Maintenance Supervisor. Under minimal supervision performs a variety of moderately complex duties including advanced mechanical maintenance on various vehicles and specialized equipment.

Essential Functions:

- Tests, tunes, diagnoses, and repairs gasoline and diesel vehicles and equipment such as: light, medium, and heavy-duty trucks, mowers, tractors, front-end loaders, backhoe, and components to include suspension systems, tires, hydraulic and air brakes, electrical and ignition systems, drive-train and manual transmissions, clutches and rear axle assemblies, cooling and heating, fuel and exhaust systems, other engine and specialized system components
- Performs repairs and adjustments to specialized Airport equipment, such as rotary snow brooms, blowers, and liquid/sand dispensing systems
- Schedules and performs preventive maintenance on all MAAP vehicles and equipment
- Operates equipment such as small loaders, road plows, sweepers, tractors, and mowers
- Operates advanced heavy equipment such as trucks with snow removal attachments, large tractors and road grader
- Ability to operate automotive machine shop equipment such as press, gas and electric welding apparatus, drill press and related shop equipment
- Maintains clean and safe working environment
- Keeps service maintenance records and orders supplies
- Will be assigned as a dedicated member of a snow removal crew
- Must be willing to work variable hours, to include weekend and holidays
- Must be willing to work on an on-call basis

Requirements:

Associate's degree or equivalent from two-year College or technical school in repair of gasoline/diesel-powered vehicles and equipment and one-year related experience in repair of gasoline/diesel-powered vehicles and equipment

Licenses; Certificates; Special Requirements:

- Pass a post-offer/pre-employment physical examination and drug screen; ability to pass a criminal history background check
- Must possess a valid Illinois Commercial Driver's License (CDL) or ability to obtain within 30 days from date of hire.
- Must obtain and maintain a Security Identification Display Area (SIDA) Badge
- Must obtain and maintain an airport movement area driver's permit within 90 days from date of hire
